Prior to his appointment, Mr. Moallim served as a Humanitarian Coordinator with the Turkish Red Crescent during the 2011 famine, where he played a key role in coordinating large-scale humanitarian response operations. He also

held senior advisory positions within the Government of Somalia, including Senior Advisor at the Ministry of Interior and Federal Affairs and Humanitarian Advisor and Public Relations Coordinator in the Office of the President. His contributions to the humanitarian sector have been recognized through a Humanitarian Award and a Service Medal.

As Commissioner of SoDMA, Mr. Moallim provides strategic leadership in coordinating national disaster response and humanitarian action. He has strengthened partnerships with international donors, UN agencies, and local stakeholders, enhanced institutional coordination, and advanced transparent, accountable, and community-focused interventions. His leadership has contributed to improved crisis response, risk mitigation, and resilience building for vulnerable communities across Somalia.
